- 1 Stella Artois by Anheuser-Busch (Belgium) 16oz** ABV 4.2% 7
Since 1366 this Belgium Lager has been enjoyed by many sailors around the world, it's Columbia's "lightest" tap beer.
- 2 Hazy Hero by Revolution Brewing (Chicago, IL) 16 oz** ABV 7.3% 7
Gaze into the mist and discover the transcendental supremacy of American hops in a Hazy IPA. A smooth, velvety body sets the stage for big fruit-forward flavor and a refreshing finish.
- 3 Necto-Cooler by Phase Three Brewing (Lake Zurich, IL) 10.5oz** ABV 5.7% 7
This sour ale pours green with the flavor of your favorite Hi-C beverage from back in the day - we put a bunch of tangerine and orange puree into this holiday treat.
- 4 Sun Crusher by Revolution Brewing (Chicago, IL) 16oz** ABV 5.3% 7
Cool off this Summer with a juicy and refreshing Chicago favorite built for the season. Bask in radiant citrus notes while soaking up its floral ambiance. By the time the leaves change, our Summer Ale will be just a sun-dappled memory, so crush a few while you've got the chance.
- 5 Beer for Huddles by Off Color Brewing (Chicago, IL) 16oz** ABV 5.2% 7
As the foliage color fades and the grunts of late summer two-a-days subside, our thirst also transitions into the warm coziness of richer flavors. Sub in Beer for Huddles. Tree resin amber in color and aromas of warm biscuits, this traditional amber drives deeper into Flavortown with pan browned pie crust overtones as well as hints of rose incense and early autumn dried leaves. If you get your third down you may just want to go for it on the fourth.
- 6 Zombie Dust by Three Floyds Brewing Co. (Munster, IN) 16 oz** ABV 6.5% 7
This intensely hopped and gushing undead Pale Ale will be one's only respite after the zombie apocalypse. Created with our marvelous friends in the comic industry.
- 7 2020 Expedition Stout by Bell's Brewery (Comstock, MI) 10.5oz** ABV 13.4% 11
This 12-month barrel-aged version of our award-winning Expedition Stout thirsts for travel, but is perfectly content to sit in your cellar, maturing, until you are ready. The tough part? Deciding if you want to enjoy it now or wait until later. You can't go wrong either way.
- 8 805 Cerveza by Firestone Walker Brewing Co. (Paso Robles, CA) 16 oz** ABV 4.5% 7
A new light beer with a simple twist. Easy drinking – Lime included. Built for a life well lived across any border and imported from California. Una mas Cerveza.
- 9 Stay Wild by Phase Three Brewing (Lake Zurich, IL) 16 oz** ABV 7.7% 7
Hazy Double IPA that utilizes the best of both beers. Creamy flaked oats and an abundance of amarillo and citra hops from our beloved Full Frame and heaps of Mosaic from Perpetual Sounds were brought together to showcase this dank Pacific Northwest hop combo.
- 10 Oberon Eclipse by Bell's Brewery (Comstock, MI) 16 oz** ABV 6.3% 7
Oberon Eclipse is a citrus wheat ale that brightens up those winter nights with a bright orange and warm coriander citrus flavor and taste.

- 11 Neighborly Stout by Begyle Brewing Co. (Chicago, IL) 16 oz** ABV 6% 7
Dubbed a "Double Dry Stout"--a collaboration with Chicago's Ork Posters to commemorate the opening of their retail shop, Neighborly. This stout drinks smooth and dry with a roasty backbone--like a good dry stout should .
- 12 Guinness by Guinness LTD. (Ireland) 16 oz** ABV 4.2% 7
Malty sweetness and a hoppy bitterness, with notes of coffee and chocolate. A roasted flavor also comes through, courtesy of the roasted unmalted barley that goes into its brewing. It has a sweet nose, with hints of malt breaking through, and its palate is smooth, creamy, and balanced.

| Two Hearted by Bells, IPA (Kalamazoo, MI) 12oz | <i>ABV 7%</i> | \$7 |
| This brew is defined by its intense hop aroma and malt balance. Massive additions of hops in the kettle and again in the fermenter lend their characteristic grapefruit and pine resin aromas. A significant malt body balances this hop presence. | | |
| Ninja vs Unicorn by Pipeworks, Double IPA (Chicago, IL) 16oz | <i>ABV 8.0%</i> | \$9 |
| Brewed with over five pounds of hops per barrel, this unfiltered double IPA is sure to please the most discerning hop lover. | | |
| Robert The Bruce by Three Floyds, Scotch Ale (Munster, IN) | <i>ABV 6.5%</i> | \$8 |
| A bold Scottish ale with a complex malty body derived from roasted and crystal malts balanced with just the right combination of hops. This ale pours a deep ruby color, has a sweet malty nose with layered caramel and roasted notes and a full body. Robust yet smooth, Robert The Bruce is a malt lover's delight. | | |

Budweiser by Anheuser-Busch (St. Louis, Missouri) 12oz ABV 5%, \$4

Brewed and sold since 1876, "The King of Beers" is the largest-selling beer in the world. Brewed with 100% natural ingredients. We use only the finest hops, barley malt, rice, yeast, and water. We craft and age Budweiser using time-honored brewing methods.

Bud Light by Anheuser-Busch (St. Louis, Missouri) 12oz ABV 4.2% \$4

Corona by Grupo Modelo, Pale Lager (México DF, Mexico) 12oz ABV 4.5%, IBU 40 \$6

Corona Extra is the number-one selling beer in Mexico and the leading export brand from Mexico. This pilsner type beer was first brewed in 1925 by Cerveceria Modelo, located in Mexico City.

Modelo Especial by Grupo Model, Pale Lager (México DF, Mexico) 12oz ABV 4.5%, \$6

Modelo Especial, a pilsner type beer, was introduced to the market in 1966. Today it is sold in glass bottles as well as cans, which are having an increasing demand due to consumer preferences, making Modelo Especial the leader in the can segment in Mexico.

Coors Lite by Coors Brewing Company (Golden, CO) 12oz ABV 4.2% \$4

Miller Lite by Miller Brewing Company (Milwaukee, WI) 12oz ABV 4.2% \$4
