- 1 Stella Artois by Anheuser-Busch (Belgium) 16oz** ABV 4.2% 7
Since 1366 this Belgium Lager has been enjoyed by many sailors around the world, it's Columbia's "lightest" tap beer.
 - 2 Hazy Hero by Revolution Brewing (Chicago, IL) 16 oz** ABV 7.3% 7
Gaze into the mist and discover the transcendental supremacy of American hops in a Hazy IPA. A smooth, velvety body sets the stage for big fruit-forward flavor and a refreshing finish.
 - 3 Mini Unicorn by Pipeworks Brewing Co. (Chicago, IL) 16oz** ABV 5% 7
If you had a trapper keeper in the year 2000, you may know the vibes! Mini Unicorn is a smaller, more mini, version of Ninja vs Unicorn! Instead of a Double IPA, this is a straight up 5% IPA absolutely bursting with hop aroma. This might just be a new favorite - and
 - 4 Sun Crusher by Revolution Brewing (Chicago, IL) 16oz** ABV 5.3% 7
Cool off this Summer with a juicy and refreshing Chicago favorite built for the season. Bask in radiant citrus notes while soaking up its floral ambiance. By the time the leaves change, our Summer Ale will be just a sun-dappled memory, so crush a few while you've got the chance.
 - 5 Amber Ale by Alaskan Brewing Co. (Juneau, AK) 16oz** ABV 5.2% 7
Richly malty and long on the palate, with just enough hop backing to make this beautiful amber colored "alt" style beer notably well balanced.
 - 6 P3 Pils by Phase 3 Brewing (Lake Zurich, IL) 16 oz** ABV 4.7% 7
This american-style pilsner saw a couple changes this time around, mainly a switch from 2-row barley to 6-row american barley. This will provide a distinct character unique to american lagers. We took the ABV down from 5% to 4.7% to further increase the drinkability. Lightly-hopped to provide balance to the malt. This beer isn't hoppy, it isn't malty, it's simple at its core and the perfect companion to hiking, grilling, sitting by the pool, or enjoying in a hammock.
 - 7 2021 KBS by Founders Brewing (Grand Rapids, MI) 10.5oz** ABV 12% 10
This beer taught us that patience truly is a virtue. KBS is a big imperial stout brewed with a massive amount of coffee and chocolate and then bourbon barrel-aged to perfection. Incredibly silky and full-bodied with notes of vanilla, cocoa, roasted coffee and charred oak.
 - 8 Lager for the Lakes by Bell's Brewery (Comstock, MI) 16 oz** ABV 5.3% 7
Following in the tradition of Czech Pilsners this crushable lager offers a combination of firm malt and herbal hop bitterness. This beer is as refreshing and crisp as a swim in the Great Lakes.
 - 9 Stay Wild by Phase Three Brewing (Lake Zurich, IL) 16 oz** ABV 7.7% 7
Hazy Double IPA that utilizes the best of both beers. Creamy flaked oats and an abundance of amarillo and citra hops from our beloved Full Frame and heaps of Mosaic from Perpetual Sounds were brought together to showcase this dank Pacific Northwest hop combo.
 - 10 Hopslam by Bell's Brewery (Comstock, MI) 10.5 oz** ABV 10% 9
Starting with six different hop varieties added to the brew kettle & culminating with a massive dry-hop addition of Simcoe hops, Bell's Hopslam Ale possesses the most complex hopping schedule in the Bell's repertoire.

- 11 Fat Pug by Maplewood Brewery (Chicago, IL) 16 oz** ABV 5.9% 7
With welcoming notes of dark chocolate and coffee, this Milk Stout combines a variety of roasted grains to produce a complex yet mellow flavor.
 - 12 Guinness by Guinness LTD. (Ireland) 16 oz** ABV 4.2% 7
Malty sweetness and a hoppy bitterness, with notes of coffee and chocolate. A roasted flavor also comes through, courtesy of the roasted unmalted barley that goes into its brewing. It has a sweet nose, with hints of malt breaking through, and its palate is smooth, creamy, and balanced.

Real fruit juice gives the new Stiegl Radler a distinct, tart aroma and natural cloudiness		
Krombacher Pils by Krombacher, Pilsner (North Rhine-Westphalia) 16oz	<i>ABV 4.8%</i>	\$7
With Krombacher Pils you enjoy a distinctive, finely bitter taste and a full-flavored aroma – this is a genuine premium pilsner beer.		
El Sully by 21st Amendment, Pale Lager (San Fran, CA) 12oz	<i>ABV 4.9%</i>	\$6
A crisp Mexican-style lager with light notes of spice from Northern Brewer hops.		
Alaskan Amber by Alaskan, Amber Ale (Juneau, AK) 12oz	<i>ABV 5.3%</i>	\$7
Richly malty and long on the palate, with just enough hop backing to make this beautiful amber colored beer notably well-balanced.		
Blue Moon by Coors Brewing Company (Colorado) 12oz	<i>ABV 5.4%</i>	\$6
Witbier style ale brewed by Coors Brewing Company located in Colorado. Keith Villa, the brew master, crafted this beer inspired by Belgian wits that he got to taste during his study of brewing in Belgium.		
Bodem by Half Acre, IPA (Chicago, IL) 16oz	<i>ABV 6.7%</i>	\$7
Bodem represents how we're feeling about go-to IPA in today's spectrum of plants and brewing perspective. Idaho 7, Mosaic Cryo and Cashmere spread over a silk-rich grist.		
Two Hearted by Bells, IPA (Kalamazoo, MI) 12oz	<i>ABV 7%</i>	\$7
This brew is defined by its intense hop aroma and malt balance. Massive additions of hops in the kettle and again in the fermenter lend their characteristic grapefruit and pine resin aromas. A significant malt body balances this hop presence.		
Ninja vs Unicorn by Pipeworks, Double IPA (Chicago, IL) 16oz	<i>ABV 8.0%</i>	\$9
Brewed with over five pounds of hops per barrel, this unfiltered double IPA is sure to please the most discerning hop lover.		
Robert The Bruce by Three Floyds, Scotch Ale (Munster, IN)	<i>ABV 6.5%</i>	\$8
A bold Scottish ale with a complex malty body derived from roasted and crystal malts balanced with just the right combination of hops. This ale pours a deep ruby color, has a sweet malty nose with layered caramel and roasted notes and a full body. Robust yet smooth, Robert The Bruce is a malt lover's delight.

Budweiser by Anheuser-Busch (St. Louis, Missouri) 12oz ABV 5%, \$4

Brewed and sold since 1876, "The King of Beers" is the largest-selling beer in the world. Brewed with 100% natural ingredients. We use only the finest hops, barley malt, rice, yeast, and water. We craft and age Budweiser using time-honored brewing methods.

Bud Light by Anheuser-Busch (St. Louis, Missouri) 12oz ABV 4.2% \$4

Introduced nationally in 1982, Bud Light is brewed with a malt and hops ratio different from Budweiser for a distinctively crisp taste with fewer calories.

Corona by Grupo Modelo, Pale Lager (México DF, Mexico) 12oz ABV 4.5%, IBU 40 \$6

Corona Extra is the number-one selling beer in Mexico and the leading export brand from Mexico. This pilsner type beer was first brewed in 1925 by Cerveceria Modelo, located in Mexico City.

Modelo Especial by Grupo Model, Pale Lager (México DF, Mexico) 12oz ABV 4.5%, \$6

Modelo Especial, a pilsner type beer, was introduced to the market in 1966. Today it is sold in glass bottles as well as cans, which are having an increasing demand due to consumer preferences, making Modelo Especial the leader in the can segment in Mexico.

Coors Lite by Coors Brewing Company (Golden, CO) 12oz ABV 4.2% \$4

First, aged (lagered) below freezing to give the beer its crisp taste. Then it's filtered cold so that it gets that brilliant, bright appearance.

Miller Lite by Miller Brewing Company (Milwaukee, WI) 12oz ABV 4.2% \$4

This carefully crafted pilsner uses the finest ingredients and brewing techniques to ensure rich, full-bodied beer taste at only 96 calories.

High Life by Miller Brewing Company (Milwaukee, Wisconsin) 12oz ABV 4.6% \$4
